Drop off books and set up display.

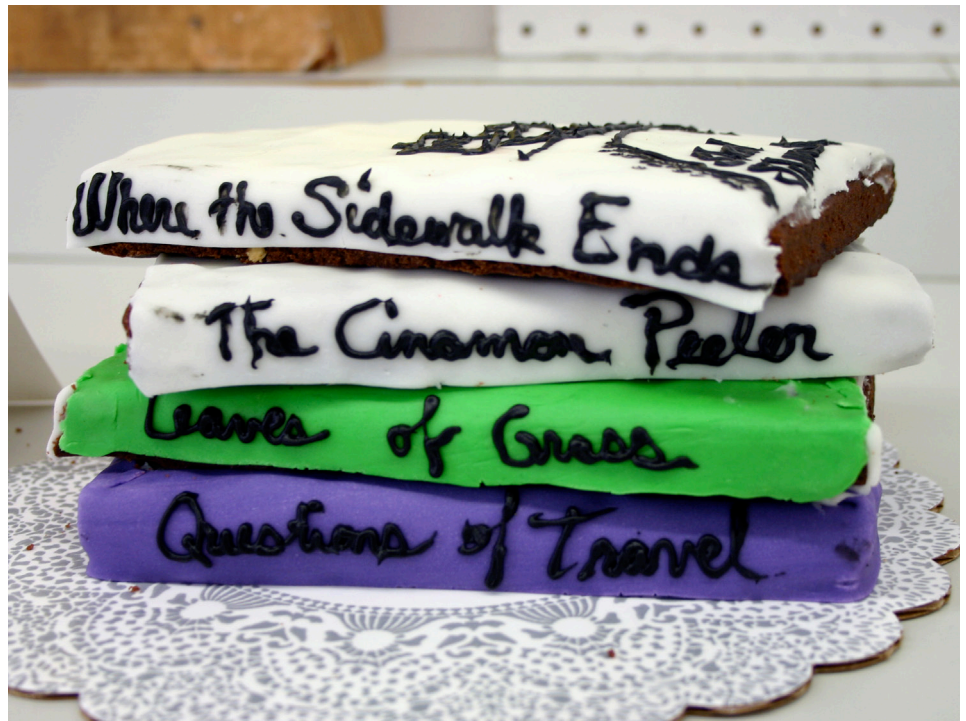
10 – 11 AM
